The wet pour for the Play Area was discussed and it was agreed to visit a nearby Play Area to find out what material was being placed around their play equipment as wet pour was proving very expensive. Previously DHL Gwynne Fencing had spread the two previous bags of bark around the equipment at a cost of £30.00. The Clerk had contacted Carmarthenshire County Council regarding their previous inspection and they reported that only the Moderate and High Risk issues they were advising needed priority.
